Maritime Freight volume 2016 (1,000 ton)





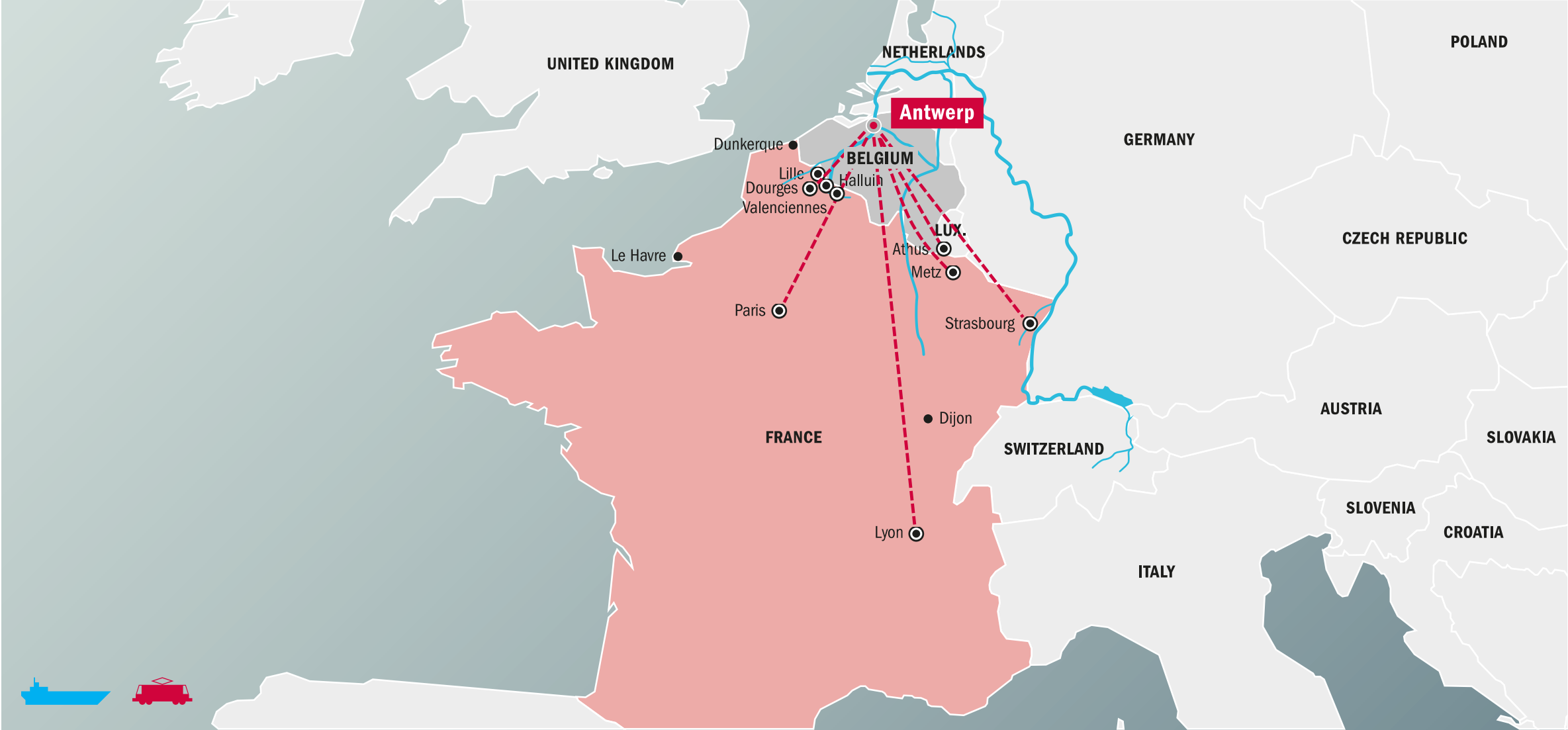

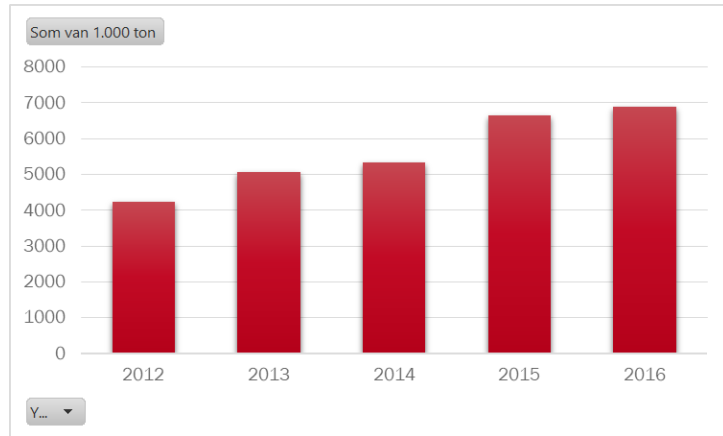

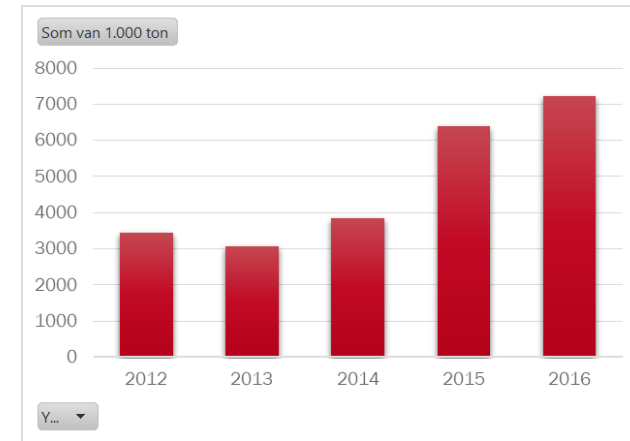

Total volume: + 80%

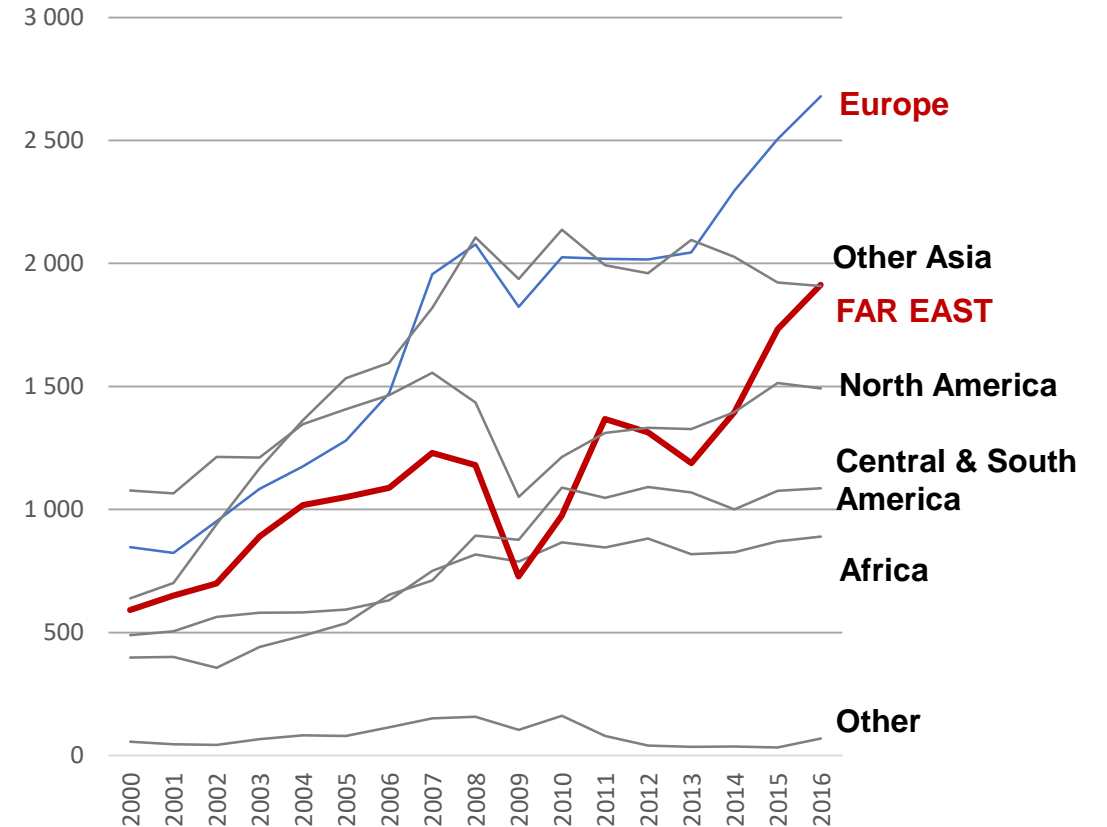


Containers: + 105%



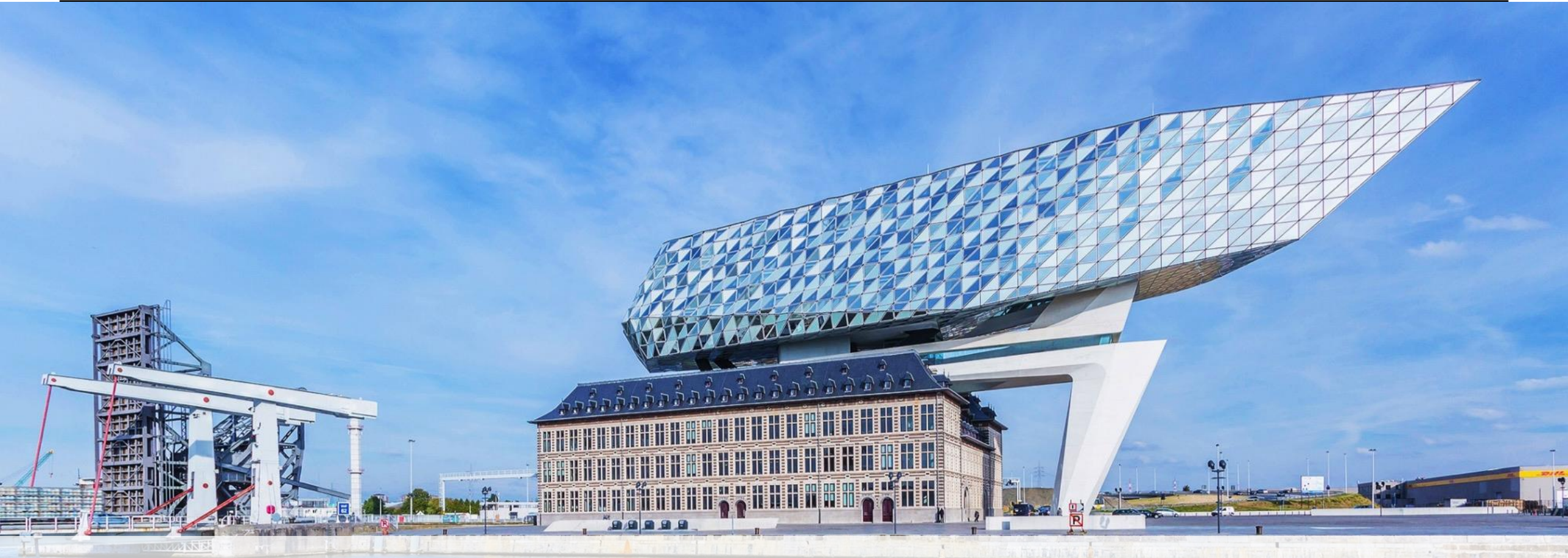
